






C. Mentorship Lounge

Terms and Conditions*

1. Placement Opportunities:

- The partnering company agrees to bring at least 2 current vacant positions or potential internship program by contributing to the career fair offering meaningful opportunities to the attending job seekers and students.
- The company shall provide detailed information about the positions available, including job descriptions, requirements, and application processes prior to the career fair.

2. Attendee Information:

- The Partnering company will provide the names and contact details of the representatives or colleagues who will be attending the event on behalf of the company.
- Partnering company will be responsible to ensure conduct of the nominated attendee and adherence to IBA's code of conduct.

3. Setup and Preparation:

 The Partnering company and sponsors will be responsible for setting up their booth or exhibit area prior to the scheduled start time of the event. CDC will inform about the security protocol for setup and preparation in due course.

4. Vehicle Restrictions:

- No heavy vehicles, including trucks or large commercial vehicles, will be allowed on the premises of the event venue on the day of the event.
- The company should make arrangements for any necessary equipment or materials to be transported and set up using appropriate vehicles that adhere to the venue's policies.





5. Payment and Confirmation:

- All Partnership fees, if applicable, should be paid in accordance with terms mention in the partner agreement.
- The partnership fees will be considered confirmed upon receipt of payment and the acceptance of the terms and conditions mentioned in the partner agreement.

6. Cancellation Policy:

 Any cancellation of partnership must be communicated in writing to the event organizers at least 20 days before the event. Any cancellation after this date will be subject to 25% cancellation charges.

7. Compliance with Event Rules:

 The partnering company agrees to adhere to all rules and regulations set forth by the event organizers, including but not limited to event timings, booth setup guidelines, and code of conduct.

8. Liability and Insurance:

 The Partnering company is responsible for its own liability and insurance coverage for the event. The event organizers will not be held liable for any loss or damage incurred by the partnering company during the event.
